CA/35/25	Action Plan and Audit - Reviewed on Teams – agreed that actions completed will be coloured green. - Watery Lane update (405/11) KC reported that a recent storm had brought down a large tree limb partially blocking the PROW. She has reported the incident to CC and posted warnings for users. The walkway is now clear and usable but a further assessment of potential danger from the remainder of the tree will be undertaken. - Pengelly bridge update (405/7) The bridge over the stream on the parish boundary has rotted and is no longer useable, this is restricting access to PROW in the next parish. Following a site meeting with Penny Hodgson (CC) a joint approach to replacing the bridge was agreed. CC would provide and deliver all the materials and CAP volunteers would build the replacement bridge according to the CC design drawings. PH has confirmed the budget is in place for May 2025 to include replacement gate posts. KC to negotiate with the farmer for access to deliver materials.	HB/IKB KC
CA/36/25	Local Maintenance Partnership – KC and D Kennedy have chased progress on Grampound with Creed parish re-joining the LMP. Steve Kempthorne CC has confirmed that orders for 25/26 are being raised this week. £445.53 would be available to pay approved contractors for PROW maintenance for the financial year 2025/26	

CA/37/25	Funding a. Bid with Heritage Centre to Grampound Community Fund The funding application has been submitted. We have changed the anticipated start and completion dates of the project to 1st June 2025 and 31st October 2025 to accommodate the panel meeting (12th May) and final outcome (end of May). b. Application to Cornwall Councillor's Community Chest As M Bunney was not standing for re-election, we would now have to apply to the newly elected Cornwall Councillor after 1st May. Lisa Grigg CC will send us the application form when the scheme reopens.	
CA/38/25	Garlenick (405/9) Outcome of Public Enquiry 1st - 3rd October 2024 There were 2 orders by Cornwall Council that were objected to by the landowner, one of which related to PROWs in our parish. Both orders have since been confirmed by the Inspector although no changes have yet been made to CC Definitive Map. KC, at their request, met with the landowners to hear and discuss their concerns related to the impact of the decisions that relate to PROW in GwC Parish. Pending due process, it may be possible to apply (or support an application) for a Modification Order in relation to the footpath running through the house garden. It was agreed that we should promote the principals of the Countryside Code in our actions wherever possible.
